And the Itsy Bitsy Spider went up the spout again.

*(creep your fingers up child again)*



## Roly Poly

Roly Poly—Roly Poly— Up Up Up

*(reach baby's arms up in the air)*

Roly Poly— Roly Poly— Down Down Down

*(lower arms to the floor)*

Roly Poly— Roly Poly— Out Out Out

*(stretch arms out to the sides)*

Roly Poly— Roly Poly— In In In!

*(brings hands together and clap)*

*(try doing the song very slow, then repeat the song faster)*



## My Arms Go Up

My arms go up

*(help baby raise hands above her head)*

And I'm so tall!

My arms go down

*(lower arms toward the floor)*

And now I'm small!

*(to the tune of “Twinkle Twinkle”)*

*(wave hands in the air)*

## Round and Round the Garden

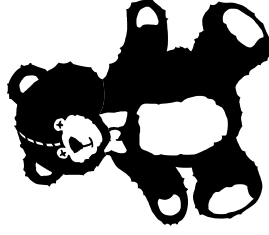
Round and round the garden goes the teddy bear

## This Little Piggy

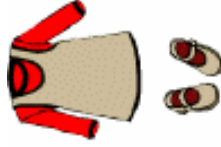
This little piggy went to market.
